

Screening and assessment tools should focus on key predictors of youth homelessness, which may illuminate challenges experienced before or during an experience of homelessness.



### **Assessing Eligibility**

Programs must answer three questions:

- 1. Who is the population of interest?
- 2. What are their immediate needs?
- 3. How can those needs be addressed?



# Considerations for Practice

#### **Fidelity**

- Articulate your program's unique assessment process
- Build assessments into workstreams
- Follow measurement guidance
- Ensure fidelity to your program's established process

### **Program/Community Fit**

- Select the tools that are right for the aims of your program
- Bring young people into this conversation to give feedback on assessment tools/processes

# Effective and Evidence-Based Measurement Tools

Programs should rely on evidencebased measurement tools that are:

RELEVANT

Capture an outcome that is related to ending YYA homelessness

PPROPRAITE

Be relevant and developmentally appropriate for YYA

ALID A Measure what they claim to measure and produce consistent results over time

FEASIBLE

Be brief and easy for programs to use, including no or low cost

Search and access screening and assessment tools.
